

## Graduation Requirements

To receive a high school graduation diploma, a student requires a minimum of 24 high school (Grades 9 - 12) credits (one credit is awarded for the successful completion for each full one year-long course). The following table specifies the required distribution of credits:

4.0 credits of English	2.0 credits in Physical Ed.
3.0 credits of Social Sci.	0.5 credit in Health
3.0 credits of Science	0.5 credit in Computer Sci.
3.0 credits of Math	3.0 Academic Electives
2.0 credits in 1 World Lang.	2.0 General Electives
1.0 credits in the Arts	<b>= 24.0 Total Credits</b>

Students transferring to M'KIS part-way through high school will receive transfer credits, at the discretion of the M'KIS school administration, for similar courses taken at their previous high school.

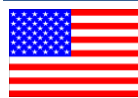

## Student Body

M'KIS has over 1000 students with 450 enrolled in the Middle School and High School. These students are representative of 53 different countries spanning the entire globe. The student body is truly international in its make-up with students from each inhabited continent in attendance at the school.

There are 53 members in the Class of 2012, 49 members in the Class of 2013, and 51 members in the Class of 2014.

For the May 2011 International Baccalaureate cohort, the average points obtained by a candidate who passed the Diploma was 32 (out of 45) while the world average was 29. There were 36 Diploma Candidates, and 29 of them obtained the IB Diploma. The highest diploma points awarded to a candidate was 39. The average grade obtained at the school by a candidate who passed the Diploma was 5.17 (out of 7). Of the cohort of 14 who presented for IB certificates, 9 were awarded four or more certificates. M'KIS encourages all students to attempt the full IB Diploma program.

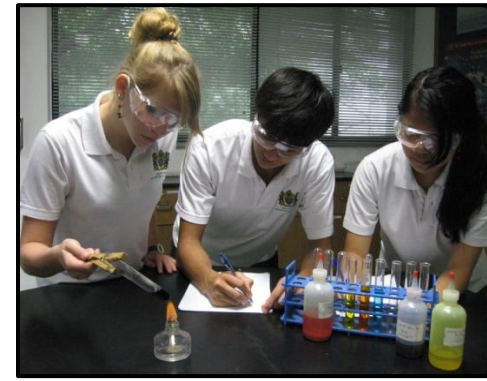
## Faculty

There are 37 faculty in the High School representing numerous countries, including United States, Canada, Australia, Chile, France, Ireland, New Zealand, Armenia, Poland, Philippines, and Malaysia. Every faculty member is trained and certified in their field of study. When combined, the High School and Middle School faculty has 51 members.

M'KIS provides students in the secondary section (Grades 6-12) with individualized attention in class where the student:faculty ratio is 9:1, and the average class size is 12 students.
